# Christmas CVC Word Game



**You will need:**

- Christmas CVC Word Game board
- a dice
- counters

# Christmas CVC Word Game

## How to Play:

1. When it is their turn, players roll the dice and move their counter the number of spaces shown on the dice.
2. The player needs to read the CVC word they land on (unless they are at the bottom of a chimney or the top of a Christmas tree - see instruction 3). If they read it correctly, they stay on that space and play continues. If they read the word incorrectly, they miss their next go.
3. If the player lands at the bottom of a chimney, they move up it and read the word at the top of the chimney. If they land at the top of a Christmas tree, they need to go down the tree and read the word on the space at the bottom of the tree.
4. The first player to reach the finish is the winner!
