

We have learnt the sounds; c k u b.

We have used the following formation ditties to help us write them.

c- curl around the caterpillar

k-down the kangaroo's body, back up, round his tummy and down his leg.

u- down and up and draw the puddle

b-down the laces to the heel and over the toes

Alongside having a go at writing the sounds we have learnt, they could also practice them in the air, paint them, chalking them on the floor/ chalk board, draw them in shaving foam, dried rice or flour etc.
