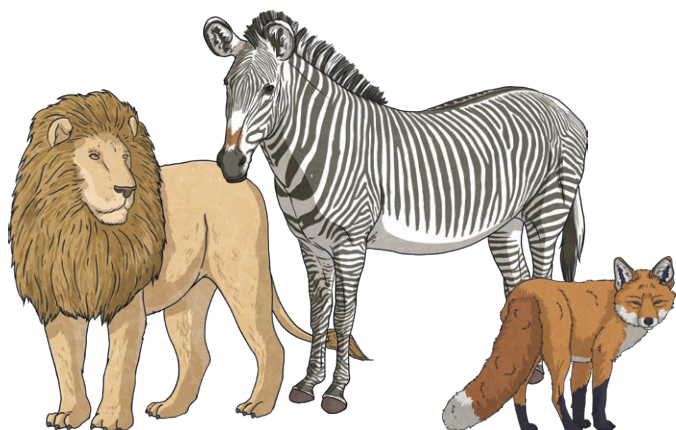


Animal Kenning
