At the beginning of the week we provide the children with a challenge to complete by the end of the week. They are able to independently choose whether they complete the 'Bronze' 'Silver' or 'Gold' challenge.

This week, your teachers would like you to design your own reading corner/space!

There are lots of different places we can read. We can read in our classrooms, in our beds, in our kitchens, or even outside when the weather is warm! Reading is so important and can be an enjoyable, relaxing activity. One important thing to remember when reading is space – where you are, what you are surrounded by, and the kind of atmosphere you create for yourself. This is why we would love to hear your ideas and see what you would like to see from a reading space!

Your reading space can be a design for outdoors OR indoors, and include as many features as you like! Remember, that this is YOUR reading space. So you can make choices based on what makes you feel relaxed and calm ☺ This challenge can be designed on paper, junk modelling, or built from construction.



Bronze- Create your design on paper, junk modelling or construction and tell an adult about what you have made. You can record yourself doing this and upload it on to class dojo if you wish.

Silver- If on paper, can you label some of the features you included? Are there bean bags? Trees? Blankets? If your design is a model, create small labels on strips of paper and place them next to the feature.

Gold- Can you write some sentences telling your teacher about why your reading space is the best reading space **EVER**? Think about the choices you have made when designing and why you have made them.
