<p>Carefully fill a bucket with water with the help of an adult - can you find five things that float, and five things that sink?</p> <p>Before you test it, see if you can make some predictions!</p>	<p>Draw a picture of a flower. Remember to draw some petals, a stem and some leaves on your flower.</p> <p>As an extra challenge, can you label the parts of your flower? Remember to use your phonics to help!</p>	<p>Play with playdough or if you have the ingredients you could create your own (See link below) and use your imagination! <p>Go on a number hunt in your house! Can you find the numbers between 1-20? Write them down as you find them. Can you count out a group of toys that is one more?</p> <p>As an extra challenge, work out one more in your head!</p>	<p>Can you find and draw five objects with square faces that are around your house? Draw a picture of these objects and label them.</p>
<p>Look at things around the room and say the sound they begin with. Can you hear the sound they end with too? Try writing some of them down.</p>	<p>Can you look at the following sounds and think of a word that begins with each one?</p> <p>t,d,c,b f,l,s,o</p>	<p>Create a picture of something you've enjoyed doing over the Easter Break and write a sentence to match it (Did you go on an egg hunt? Did you eat lots of chocolate?)</p>
