Can you choose 3 activities to do?

<p>Create your own musical instrument out of junk modelling! For example - you could fill a clean yoghurt pot with dried beans or rice and cover it with a sheet of paper to make your own shaker! What different sounds can you make?</p> 	<p>Create your own emergency vehicle. Think about features such as sirens, horns, hosepipes, ladders or bright colours. You can use resources such as lego, old boxes, bottle lids or cardboard tubes.</p> 	<p>Be an artist! Pick something from your home and draw or paint a picture of it. Can your adult at home guess what you have drawn or painted?</p>
<p>Collect 5 pebbles and 5 leaves from outside. Make a pattern that goes, 'pebble, leaf, pebble, leaf'. Can you complete it? You could paint the pebbles different colours and make patterns with the colours.</p>	<p>With a partner, draw a large 0 - 10 number line on the ground in chalk. Stand on number 10. Ask your partner to say a number between 1 - 10. Count back that number by jumping along the number line.</p>	<p>Create your own home made scales and compare the weight of some objects around the home:</p> 
<p>Create a 'treasure basket' of some of your favourite objects around your home!
