Can you choose 3 activities to do?

<p>This week's story is all about the 'seasons.' Can you pick your favourite season and draw a picture of the things that happen?</p> 	<p>Take a look inside a piece of fruit, can you see the pips? How many are there? Take a pot and place in some compost, make a hole and pop the seed inside. Cover it back over with compost. Make a label for your pot and see if you can look after your seed. Let us know what happens. (If it is an apple or pear seed it will need to be kept cool for a couple of weeks before going out in to the warm.)</p>	<p>On your daily walk, scoot or cycle or even in your garden look out for bee's or insects collecting pollen. You will see different insects on different flowers.</p>
