Can you choose 3 activities to do?

<p>Using an outdoor space or 'messy area', using shaving foam and try to form some of the letters you have learnt to write this year. You can use your hands or a paint brush! Try to start with something simple like the 'I.'</p> 	<p>How many different ways can you write your name using just a pencil? Think about size, shape, bubble writing, fancy writing etc.</p> 	<p>Sing the song 'The incy wincy spider' Can you make a spider out of resources you have at home? Try using pom poms, a ping pong ball or even a rolled up sock! Act out the song using your new spider.</p> 
<p>Create a model lego bridge and place it over a material to create a river. How can you test the strength of your bridge?</p> 	<p>Create a group of toys and grab a dice. Roll the dice and take away that many toys. How many do you have left over?</p> 	<p>Design and make your own foil boat, count how many coins it can hold until it sinks.</p> 
<p>Create a 'muddy potion' outside using water and natural resources! Remember to tell an adult the recipe.</p> 	<p>Can you use a strategy to find a double of these numbers.</p> <p>3</p> <p>6</p> <p>9</p> <p>You can either use counters or your fingers to help. Remember, doubling is adding together the same number.</p>	<p>Create these 2D Shapes and cut them out of paper and practice 'halving' these. Remember to fold them to check that they are both the same.</p> <p>Circle Triangle Square Rectangle.</p>
