Busy Learning Time

Can you choose 3 activities to do?

<p>Ask a grown up about the game tiddly winks? Using counters or coins have a go at flipping them into a target area. How many points can you get?</p> 	<p>Roll a dice and add the same amount of coins. How many do you have now? You may choose to work in 1p's or challenge yourself when the 2 and 5 is rolled and use the 2p and 5p.</p>	<p>Create a few coin caterpillars and work out how much they are worth? Maybe the shorter caterpillar will be worth more?</p>
<p>Using penne pasta, and a piece of string/ribbon/thread make yourself or someone you love a necklace.</p> <p>You may even choose to colour the pasta with felt tip pens or paint or glitter before threading it.</p>	<p>Using a 'loose parts' material eg: pasta, lentils, rice, pebbles, sticks, bottle tops, buttons...</p> <p>Can you create a picture? Just placing the items together in a design- they are not stuck down, they can just continue to be moved.</p> 	<p>Pretend you are a turtle going for a slow, relaxed turtle walk.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Oh no, it's started to rain!</li><li>• Curl up tight under your shell for about ten seconds.</li><li>• The sun's out again, so come out of your shell and return to your relaxing walk.</li><li>• Repeat a few times, making sure to finish with a walk so that your body is relaxed.</li></ul>
<p>Create a capital letter bingo game.</p> 	 <p>Can you make your own 'wanted' poster for a fairy tale villain? Think about the big bad wolf or the evil queen! Try to include some sentences about what they are wanted for.</p>	<p>What is your favourite fairy tale? If you could change the ending- what would you choose to happen? Have a go at rewriting the end of the story.</p>
