- Union Jack bunting

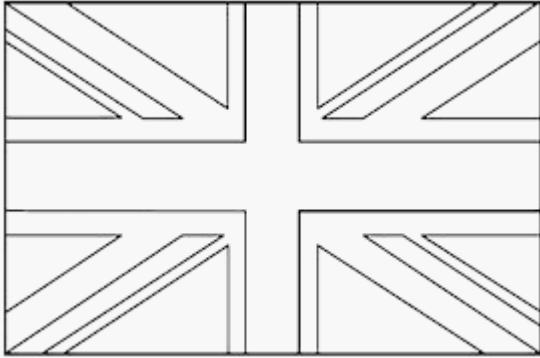


Create your own union Jack bunting using the templates provided on the school class pages.
