CLASSROOM ROUTINES

Mornings - Classroom doors open at 8:40 and close at 8.50, anyone arriving after this time will need to report to the main office.

Book bags- Should be in school daily.

Water bottles- Stored in classroom tray- children have independent access to these throughout the day.

Snack- A piece of fruit or vegetable supplied by the National Fruit and Veg scheme.

Reading books – Reading books and records should be brought into school everyday and will be changed weekly.

Library book – Changed weekly **Hedgehogs- Tuesday Squirrels- Thursday**

PE kits – Children wear their PE kit to school on their PE days. Our PE days this term are **Hedgehogs- Monday and Thursday – Squirrels - Monday and Friday**

Hometime- Doors open at 3.15.

Home/school communication – Open door policy – quick messages at door or sent via class dojo. Keep an eye on class stories and school stories to keep up to date with all messages.

Anything that needs an immediate response should go via the office.

We will be spending the next few weeks getting to know the children and how they learn effectively.

ADMIN

- If your child is absent and won't be attending school, please inform the office as well as contacting the teacher on dojo.
- Any messages on dojo will be replied to within 5 days.
- Homework – This year we are conducting a homework questionnaire for parents. Please return to your class teacher by Friday 9th September.
- Spellings- We will be completing a baseline of the children's spelling knowledge over the next few weeks.

READING

- Reading records will be looked at once a week by teachers with any comments responded to.
- RWI book which is taught in school and brought home to be read with fluency, in addition they will also bring home a shared reading book.
- RWI books are changed every week once they have been taught in school.
- The shared reading books will be changed weekly too
- The children regularly complete the RWI assessment to ensure they are being taught in the correct group and therefore reading the appropriate level book.
- It is important children are reading at home daily and the reading record is signed.
