



Date	Activity
20.04.20	<p>Create sound cards for the following sounds: m, a, s, t, d i, n, p, g, o c, k, b, u, f (If you have created these in previous sessions, please feel free to reuse)</p> <p>Flash through the cards and work on quick recall with your child. Play a game and allow the child to keep the cards they 'get' and see how many they can win! You could also say the sound and your child could have a go at writing it down. (You may want them to practice on a piece of paper first/ in their green phonics home learning book.)</p> <p>In their phonics books, can they record the sounds they hear in the words: sat pig cod</p>
21.04.20	<p>Create sound cards for the following sounds: e, l, h, sh, r j, v, y w, th (If you have created these in previous sessions, please feel free to reuse)</p> <p>Repeat the same activities as yesterday, with a focus on recall. As a challenge, call out the sound and get your child to record it in their books. After some sound recall, can your child record the sounds they hear in the words: shop thin let</p>
22.04.20	<p>Create sound cards for the following sounds: z, ch, qu, ng, nk (If you have created these in previous sessions, please feel free to reuse)</p> <p>Repeat the same activities as yesterday, with a focus on recall. As a challenge, call out the sound and get your child to record it in their books. After some recall, can your child record the sounds they hear in the words: thing pink chat</p>

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23.04.20	<p>Create the following words on strips of card:</p> <p>chat shot sink blink</p> <p>With your child, get them to draw 'sound buttons' underneath the sounds that they can spot; like the example below:</p>  <p>Support your child in cutting up the word using scissors, and practice putting them back together, reading them together as you do this until they blend the entire word.</p>
24.04.20	<p>Create the following words on strips of card:</p> <p>Chat Ship Wink Sting</p> <p>Using the same process as yesterday, read the words with your child. Next, can your child record the following words in their books; remember to ask them to record the sounds they hear.</p> <p>shop chip ping sing</p>
