# CLASSROOM ROUTINES

**Mornings** - Classroom doors open at 8:40 and **close at 8.50**- any arrivals **after 8.50** will be redirected to **sign in late at the office**

**Reading books** - Reading level books or chapter books. This week the children will take home a Library book. Please record when you have read with your child in their reading record.

**Library book** - When children visit the school library during reading time. Children's responsibility to take out of bookbag

**PE kits** – Children wear their PE kit to school on their PE days. Please label. Our PE days this year are Tuesdays and Fridays. For Year 4s, swimming is the Friday PE session.

**Swimming** – Starts Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September for Year 4.

**Breaktime Snack**- we have simplified the break time snack to fruit or raw vegetables only. This stops any ambiguity in the range of snacks that have been brought in and different interpretations of a 'healthy snack'

**Hometime**- Doors open at 3.20.

**Home/school communication** – Open door policy – quick messages at door or dojo

Teachers have 5 working days to respond to dojo messages

# ADMIN

- Homework – This year we are conducting a homework questionnaire for parents. Please return to your class teacher by Friday 19<sup>th</sup> September
- When homework commences, teachers will acknowledge receipt of the homework by 'approving' it and will add a comment if a misunderstanding or correction needs addressing. If you do not have access to a printer, please let your class teacher know so that they can provide paper copies. The homework is set on a Friday and is due in the following Friday.

# READING

- Reading books should be brought into school everyday please
- Reading records will be looked at once a week by teachers with any comments responded to.
- If your child has finished a book, we would expect them to independently let us know so they can change it.
- We will be completing a baseline of all of the children and they will know the reading band they should be choosing from or if they are a free reader. They will have a message in their reading record books that says which stage/colour they are reading or if they are a free reader. If your child was a free reader last year, they will continue to be this year.
- Reading to an adult will take place regularly.
- Children are able to log their reading themselves as part of their independent learning. Parents will need to continue to update the reading record at least weekly to feedback to teachers and to oversee the comments written by the children.

# YEAR 4 MULTIPLICATION CHECK

## Multiplication tables check

### Do you have a child in year 4 at primary school?

If so, your child will be participating in the multiplication tables check in June. The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help your child's school to identify if your child may need additional support.

### What is the Multiplication tables check?

It is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. Your child will be able to answer 3 practice questions before taking the actual check. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. On average, the check should take no longer than 5 minutes to complete.

### What if my child cannot access the check?

There are several access arrangements available for the check, these can be used to support pupils with specific needs. Your child's teacher will ensure that the access arrangements are appropriate for your child before they take the check in June.

The check has been designed so that it is inclusive and accessible to as many children as possible, including those with special educational needs or disability (SEND) or English as an additional language (EAL). However, there may be some circumstances in which it will not be appropriate for a pupil to take the check, even when using suitable access arrangements. If you have any concerns about your child accessing the check, you should discuss this with your child's headteacher.

### Do I need to do anything to prepare my child for the check?

No, you do not need to do anything additional to prepare your child for the check. As part of usual practice, teachers may ask you to practise times tables with your child.

Schools will have unlimited access to a try it out area from March. They can use this to make sure pupils have the necessary support required to access the check. This includes opportunities for pupils to familiarise themselves with the check application and try out any access arrangements that may be required.

### How will the results be used?

Schools will have access to all their pupils' results, allowing those pupils who need additional support to be identified.

### Will I receive feedback on my child's check?

Yes. Your child's teacher will share your child's score with you, as they would with all national curriculum assessments. There is no pass mark for the check.
