Here is a guide to the pronunciation of the sounds we have learnt:

ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, oo, ar, or, air, ir, ou, oy

Day	Activity
Monday 8 <sup>th</sup> June	Flash through the sound cards. Quick fire write- hay, creep, slight, elbow, boom, crook, lark, born, chair, thirteen, ground, annoy At the end we go back and the children tick their own or rewrite it correctly.
Tuesday 9 <sup>th</sup> June	Flash through the sound cards. All muddled up- below the sentence has got all muddled up, can you read the words and put them in the right order? Can you write it correctly into your book? The leef (leaf). lay the egg on
Wednesday 10 <sup>th</sup> June	Flash through the sound cards. Can you write me a short story (3 sentences or more) to go with this picture? (There is a larger one on the next page.) *let your child use their imagination or it can be as simple as 'The boy was in the feeld (field.) He found a laddir (ladder.) He went to the moon. The end.' 
Thursday 11 <sup>th</sup> June	Flash through the sound cards. Explain today we are going to look at our tricky words (words we can't sound out.) Write out the following words on to pieces of paper or card- he she we me be you are her was all they my Go through them as flash cards making a pile of known and found a bit tricky. You could give your child ownership of which pile to put it in. Look through the unknown words together. Say the word for your child to repeat. Now play a game of splat the tricky word. Include all of the known and 2 of the unknown. You say the word they splat it.
Friday 12 <sup>th</sup> June	Flash through sound cards. Head over to <a href="http://phonicsplay.co.uk">phonicsplay.co.uk</a> sign in- march20 Password- home. Click on the children's bubble and then the tab on the left-hand side that says phase 4 and open the interactive story- what did you put in my lunchbox. Read the story and write down your answer to the question at the end.
