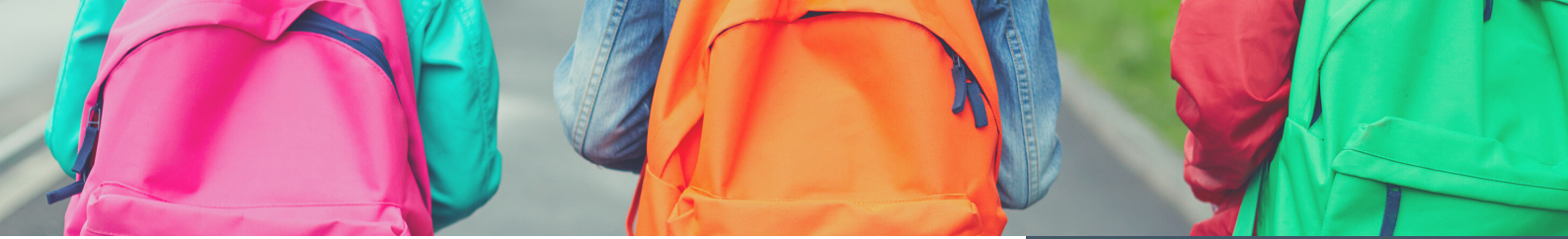

This year we have decided not to have a used toy stall so we are only looking for new items or ones in excellent condition

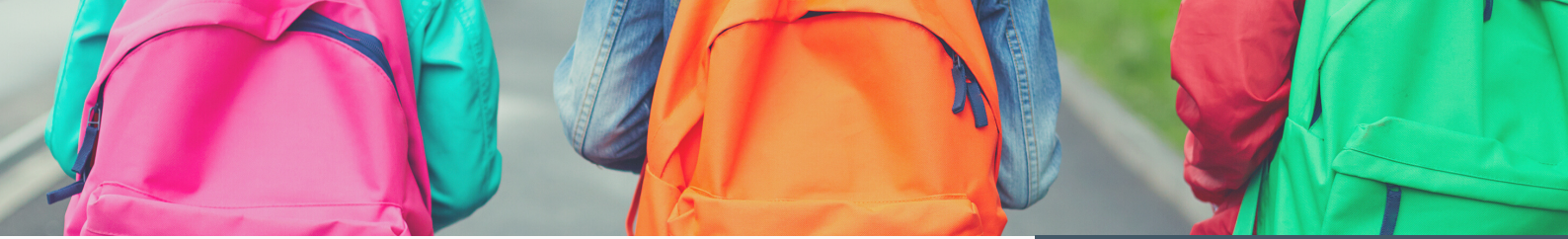
More information will be coming out but as we have done in previous years:
