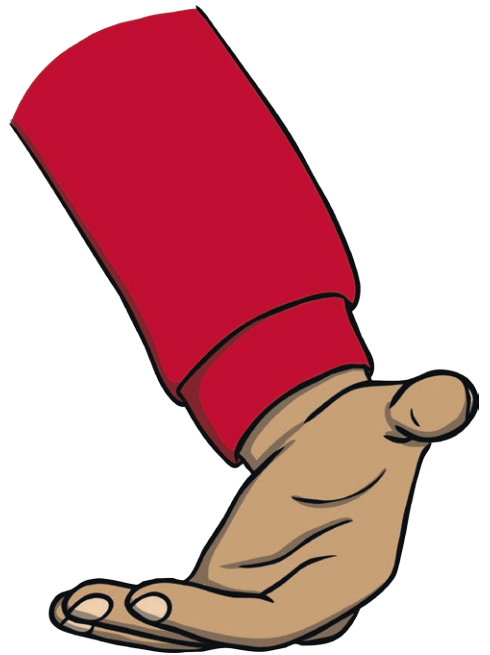
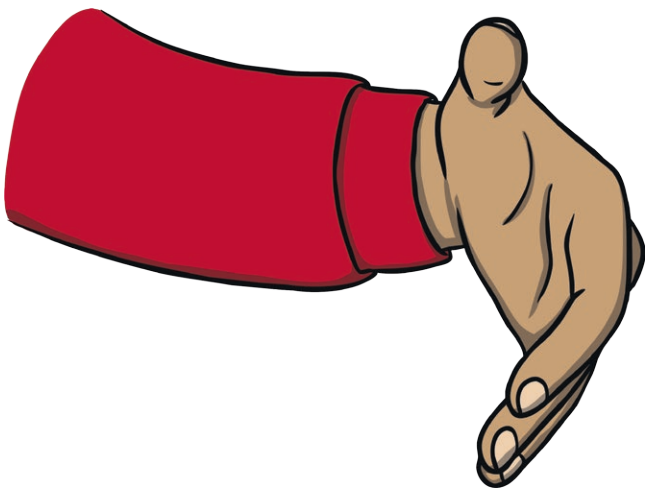


Kung Fu Sentence Cards
