

Summer Holidays Board Game

A game for 2 or more people.

You will need:

- A counter for each person. These could be buttons, milk carton tops or playing pieces from another board game, as long as they are a different colour for each player.
- A dice. If you don't have a dice, ask an adult if they could download a dice app on a tablet that you could use. Or you could cut up six pieces of paper and write numbers 1 to 6 on them. Then instead of rolling the dice, close your eyes and pick one of the pieces of paper each time.

Instructions:

- Decide who will go first. It could be the youngest player, or you could all roll the dice and the person with the highest score goes first.
- Roll the dice and move your counter along the board that number of squares.
- Look at the square you landed on. Some squares are blank, others have instructions on them. If you land on a square with an instruction on it, do what it says. Some will move you closer to the end, others will move you nearer the beginning!
- The first person to land on the final square wins.
