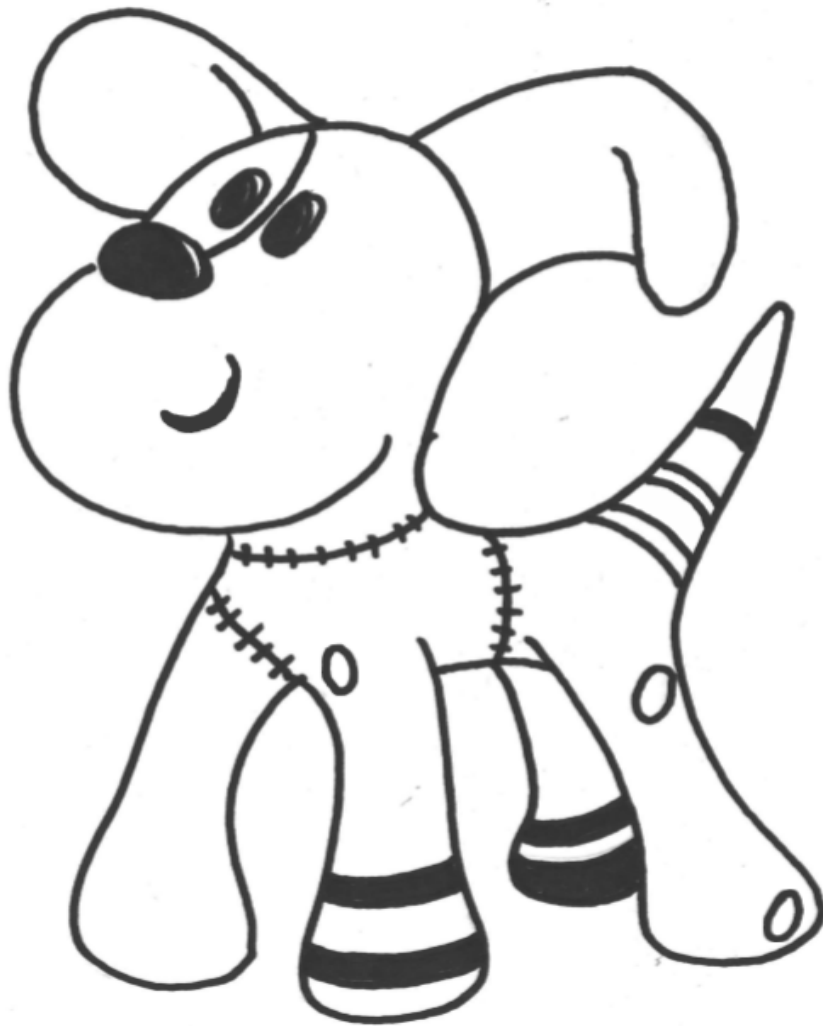

3y-4.5y - a great interaction opportunity to discuss the short piece of writing on Page 2.

4.5y-6y – a great chance to grab a cup of tea and biscuit while they go through and answer the questions on their own!

### **Page 4**

A straightforward word search... although with a twist... there are two words not on the list for the older children to try and find, and of course younger ones if they want to!

Let them look for themselves or give them clues to the animals – CAT & PIG.  
Again, depending on the age of your child will depend on how much help you give them.... Or if you want five minutes to yourself be mean and don't give them any clues!
