Christian beliefs

The 10 commandments appear in the Old Testament of the Bible.
These are rules to live by in the Christian faith.

1. Love God more than you love anything else.
2. Don't make anything in your life more important than God.
3. Always say God's name with respect.
4. Honour God by resting on the 7th day of the week.
5. Love and respect your parents.
6. Treat others with respect – never hurt anyone.
7. Always be faithful to your husband and wife.
8. Don't steal from others.
9. Always be honest.
10. Be happy with what you have.

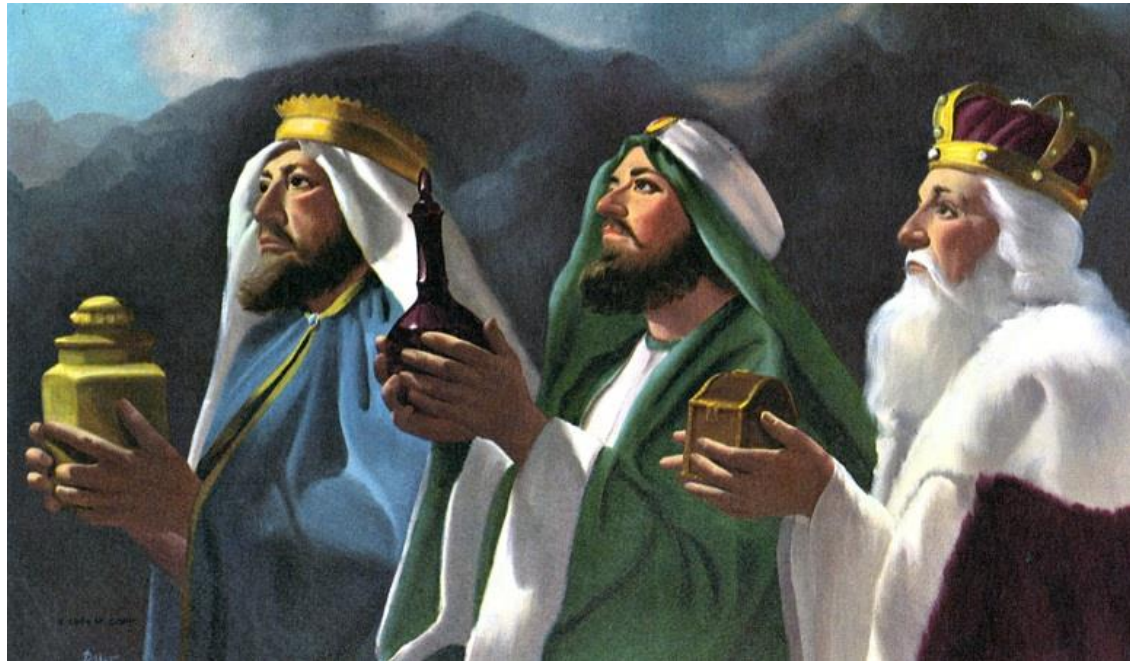
