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Teacher Notes

Learning objective

-To learn to look for links between religious stories and beliefs.

Learning outcomes

- I can retell some religious stories.
- I understand what Christians, Muslims and Sikhs believe.
- I can point out similarities and differences between stories and beliefs.

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A discussion needs to be had about why words are said after the prophet's name.

Children could write a script and then act the story out.

Main characters – The Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him), the blind man, the chiefs and a narrator.

Religious stories – expose children to as many different Christian, Muslim and Sikh stories as possible before asking them to make comparisons. A comic strip could be created with speech bubbles and text for their favourite story.
