

X-ray numbers (2+ children)

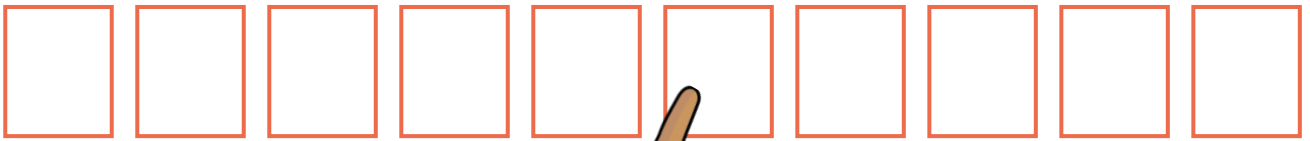


Equipment needed

- Number cards (1 – 20)

Instructions

1. Place a set of number cards from 11 to 20, facing down, **in order**.
2. Child 1 points to a card.
Use your X-ray vision to tell your partner or another child in the group the number that you think will be on the card.



I think it will be 16

3. Flip over the card to check.



4. Child 2 repeats. If there are more than two children in the group, take turns guessing a card until everyone has had a turn.

- How do you know the number is ___?
- Can you use your X-ray vision to identify different numbers?
- Can you find 1 more or 1 less using your X-ray vision?
