WHAT ARE THE CHILDREN LEARNING ABOUT THIS WEEK?

This week in Team Magic:

We have thoroughly enjoyed mud painting! In our outdoor learning session. The children enjoyed dunking their sticks in the gloopy mud and experimenting with marks on the tree and on to paper. We have explored the vocabulary from last week's story Farmer Duck with words such as wearily, creaked and crept. We have been reading the Scarecrows Wedding by Julia Donaldson and enjoying the rhyming couplets. In phonics the children have been working really hard on writing words using their sound knowledge and even making signs to stop Cruella Deville from taking the puppies! We thoroughly enjoyed World Book Day sharing our costumes with each other. As mathematicians we have been looking at 2 groups and then counting how many altogether. We have been trying hard to subitise small amounts (recognize the amount of dots/fingers without counting them first) and then adding them together.

This week in Team Believe:

This week in Squirrels we have been comparing units of measure. We have used cm and metres to measure and compare everyday objects around the school. As writers we have continued to analyse poems and find the features used. Where the children have now started to incorporate repeated phrases in their writing. To finish a fabulous week of learning, the children amazed us all with their costumes and books that they shared with friends in school.

This week, as mathematicians, Hedgehogs have been learning to partition numbers up to 50 into tens and ones. We have also looked at measuring mass using balance scales. In English, we have continued to explore features of poetry. As historians, we are learning more about Christopher Columbus and his journey. Thank you for supporting children in their research about explorers at home as part of last week homework. Hedgehogs thoroughly enjoyed their fabulous costumes and world book day activities.

This week in Team Inspire:

This week we have been focusing on poetry and the language seen. We have looked at descriptions and how we can incorporate this into our work. As mathematicians we have grasped adding two fractions. The children made fractions and recognized how to alter them. As scientists we have explored the melting points of different objects. The children were amazed by some of the results. On World Book day we looked at some of our personal books and decided why other children should read them. The children spoke about their own interpretation.
