## WHAT ARE THE CHILDREN LEARNING ABOUT THIS WEEK?

### **This week in Team Magic:**

Robin class have been doing really well settling in to all the new routines and expectations. We are thoroughly enjoying our busy learning time in the garden and I am really looking forward to starting our outdoor learning sessions next week (please ensure suits and wellies are in school.) We have been doing really well learning our first set of phonic sounds and information will be sent home with how you can support at home. In math's we have been looking at sorting and matching, next week we are moving on to sets and comparing which has more or less. We have thoroughly enjoyed the story of the colour monster to discuss different emotions and are creating our own colour monster emotion jars.

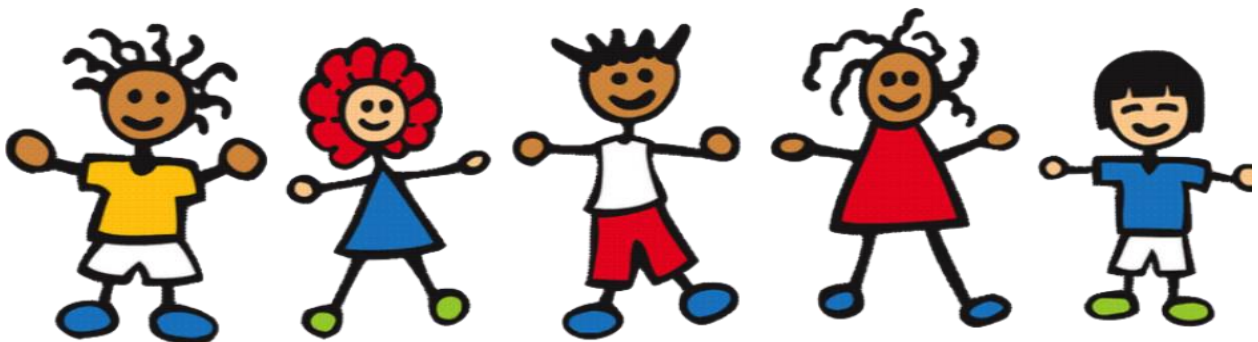
### **This week in Team Believe:**

Hedgehogs Class has been learning rhyming words and how rhyming words are used in poetry. They have thoroughly enjoyed making a story map for the poem- 'Where teachers keep their pets' and used it to recite and act out the poem. In Maths, we have been looking at one more than a number and counting backwards. As Geographers, hedgehogs have learnt about the 4 countries that make up the UK. As scientists, children have enjoyed learning about grouping animals into various categories- mammal, reptile, bird, fish and amphibian.

Squirrel class have enjoyed bringing poetry to life while acting out the poems that they are learning, in addition to this they have started to create a text map for each poem they are taught. As computer technologists, Squirrel class have started to use the ipads to complete tasks, showing an awareness of what they are creating and how to do it using a computer. As scientists we have started to explore what a lifecycle is and comparing the offspring of an adult animal or human.

### **This week in Team Inspire:**

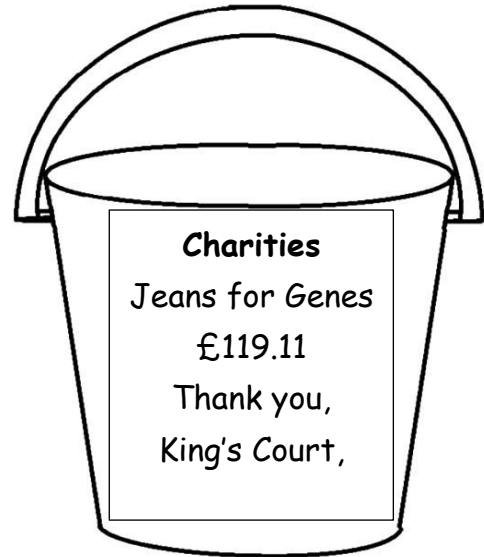
In Owls we have continued our work in poetry. We have looked at adverbials before using them in our writing. As mathematicians we have focused on place value and numbers to 1000. As scientist we have looked at food and what we should be eating. As Geographers we have moved onto locating towns in the UK. In Deer's we have been focusing on kennings and how to make them. We have gathered ideas and presented them with effective language. As mathematicians we have explored place value to 10,000 and different ways to represent numbers. As scientists we have been looking at food chains and how different animals rely on each other. As geographers we have continued our work on transport but looked at network maps.
