## Important Information

### **Re: Unsafe Parking Outside School Premises**

As a valued part of our community, King's Court is committed to fostering a safe and respectful environment for all—our students, families, staff, and local residents.

We are writing to address a concern raised regarding unsafe parking outside the school during drop-off time. This behaviour poses significant safety risks to children and other road users, and has unfortunately led to unnecessary tension within our community.

We kindly remind all parents and visitors to observe the following guidelines to help maintain a safe and harmonious environment:

### **Parking Etiquette**

- Please Park only in designated areas.
- Avoid blocking driveways, access roads, or pedestrian crossings.
- Do not park on pavements, as this obstructs safe passage for pedestrians, especially children and those with mobility needs.
- Parking on yellow zig-zag lines outside the school is illegal at all times. Rule 243 of the Highway Code prohibits parking in areas that pose safety risks, including bends, dropped kerbs, and the brow of hills.

### **Respectful Communication**

We ask everyone to engage courteously with school staff, other parents, and local residents. Aggressive or confrontational behaviour will not be tolerated and may be reported to the appropriate authorities.

### **Patience and Understanding**

Drop-off and pick-up times can be busy. Your patience and cooperation are essential in ensuring a safe and orderly environment for all.

We are actively working on solutions to improve traffic flow and parking arrangements around the school. This includes inviting our local community warden to monitor the area during peak times.

To support these efforts:

- We will begin documenting instances of illegal parking, including photographs of vehicles (make, model, and registration).
- These will be shared with the community warden for further action.

Let's work together to keep our children safe and maintain positive relationships with our neighbours.
