CLASSROOM ROUTINES

Mornings - Classroom doors open at 8:40 and close at 9.00, anyone arriving after this time will need to report to the main office.

Book bags- Should be in school daily.

Water bottles- Stored in classroom tray- children have independent access to these throughout the day.

Snack- A piece of fruit or vegetable supplied by the National Fruit and Veg scheme.

Reading books – Reading books and records should be brought into school everyday and will be changed weekly.

Library book – Changed weekly **Hedgehogs- Friday**

Squirrels- Thursday

PE kits – Children wear their PE kit to school on their PE days. Our PE days this term are **Hedgehogs- Tuesday and Friday – Squirrels - Monday and Friday**

Hometime- Doors open at 3.15.

Home/school communication – Open door policy – quick messages at door or sent via class dojo. Keep an eye on class stories and school stories to keep up to date with all messages.

Anything that needs an immediate response should go via the office.

ADMIN

- If your child is absent and won't be attending school, please inform the office as well as contacting the teacher on dojo.
- Any messages on dojo will be replied to within 5 days.
- Homework –Spellings- We will be completing a baseline of the children's spelling knowledge over the next few weeks. Homework – Homework will begin Friday 18th September. If you do not have access to a printer, please let your class teacher know so that they can provide paper copies. The homework is set on a Friday and is due in the following Friday.

READING

- Reading records will be looked at once a week by teachers with any comments responded to.
- RWI book which is taught in school and brought home to be read with fluency, in addition they will also bring home a shared reading book.
- RWI books are changed every Friday once they have been taught in school.
- The shared reading books will be changed weekly too.
- The children regularly complete the RWI assessment to ensure they are being taught in the correct group and therefore reading the appropriate level book. This is administered half-termly – in the penultimate week. Please see Mrs. Sharma for further clarification.
- It is important children are reading at home daily and the reading record is signed.

HOMEWORK

A homework outline will be given out each half term. This includes:

- Daily reading expectations
- Spellings
- Maths on TTRS platform
- A creative project
- A wellbeing project

Optional homework will be available on the school website and the newsletter. For example: If we cover place value in Maths then there will be place value activities on the website for your child to complete if they wish to. This is optional homework.

Feedback from homework will be at the end of each half term in their reading records.

SPELLINGS

Spellings will commence on Friday 18th September and the first lists will be sent home

We will be continuing with Ed Shed this year

Children will be given a spelling homework sheet each week to complete and hand back to their teacher. They can also access the Ed Shed platform to practise the spelling rule.

Spelling quizzes will happen weekly

Squirrels Class:

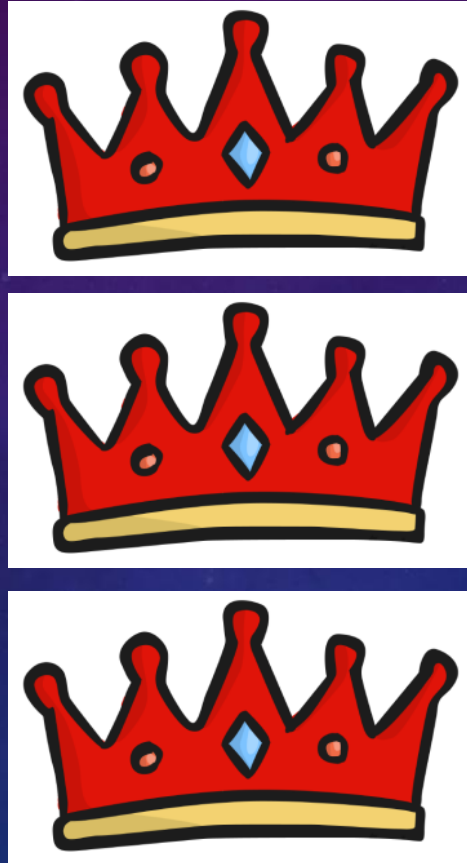
